Dr. Win's research has been published in multiple journals in the areas of diabetic retinopathy, age-related macular degeneration, vitrectomy, and intraocular tumors. He was the Outstanding Resident of the Year at the Mayo Clinic; the Rosalind Alcott Fellow in vitreoretinal surgery and Fellow of the Year at Jules Stein Eye Institute; and the recipient of the prestigious Governor Award from Gov. Arnold Schwarzenegger. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Ophthalmology, and a member of the American Academy of Ophthalmology and Association for Research in Vision and Ophthalmology.
